None had any signs of radiation sickness and all lived long lives. They attributed their protection to Our Lady after having said the rosary daily for many years.

When reciting the rosary, we are reflecting on the mysteries of Christ. It is a good way to remind ourselves of the many miraculous events surrounding the birth and death of Jesus.

During October we are joining with thousands of schools and parishes across Australia to pray for the future of our young people. I can't think of a more worthy cause.

Division


Visual representation (Drawing 10 objects)


Repeated addition(1+1+1+1+1+1+1+1+1)


