## NSW Premier's Reading Challenge for 2019

The **Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)** is a Government initiative to encourage students across Years K – 9 to read a variety of books by different authors.

The PRC officially starts at the beginning of **March** every year and runs until the end of **August**. This year the PRC starts on **4<sup>th</sup> March** and closes **30<sup>th</sup> August**.

Students in Years K-2 who read 30 books (with a minimum of 25 from the approved PRC Booklist) and students in Years 3-6 who read 20 books (minimum 15 from the approved PRC Booklist) are awarded a certificate from the Premier at the completion of the challenge. Students who wish to participate will need to enter their own reading records online by logging on to the PRC website at <https://online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc/home.html> prior to the close of the PRC in the middle of August 2019.

The easiest and most reliable way to enter the PRC books online is by the book ID number. This can be found on the inside cover of our school PRC library books or alternatively they can be viewed on the PRC website.

**Those students who already have their PRC username and password from previous years can log on from 4<sup>th</sup> March and update their registered details.**

The Library has a large collection of books on separate shelves to support students who wish to participate in the challenge. Students are encouraged to borrow extra books for the PRC during lunchtime.

**Students new to the challenge will be required to register for the challenge by completing the registration form attached. Existing students need to indicate their intention to re-join the challenge and whether or not they need to be given their usernames and passwords again.**
