- Complete and submit quiz questions (this will take approximately 10 minutes).

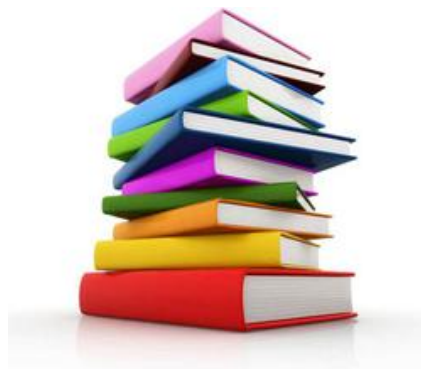
Bee-Bots!
