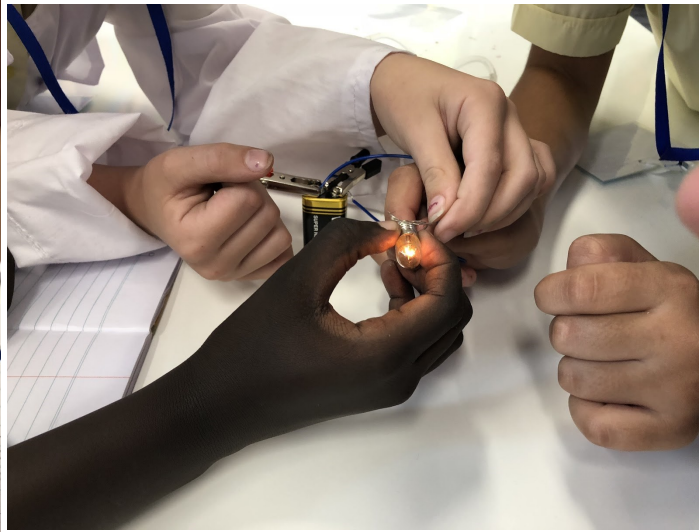
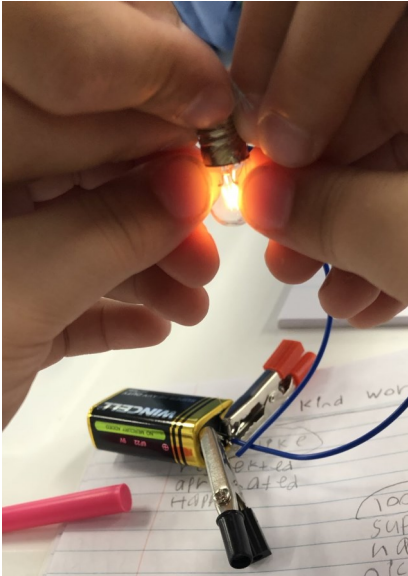
Year One shared their favourite monster stories with a special visitor. Mrs Reilly thought the stories were a bit scary, but we thought they were really funny.







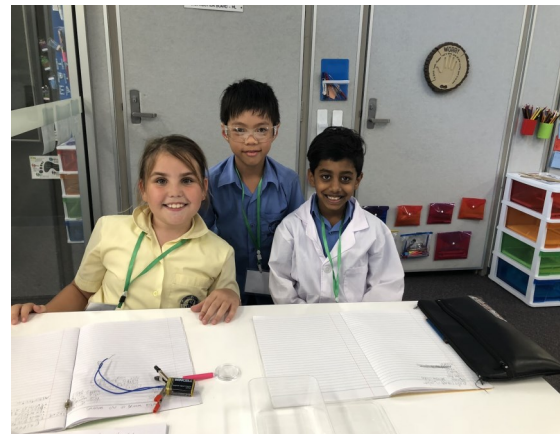
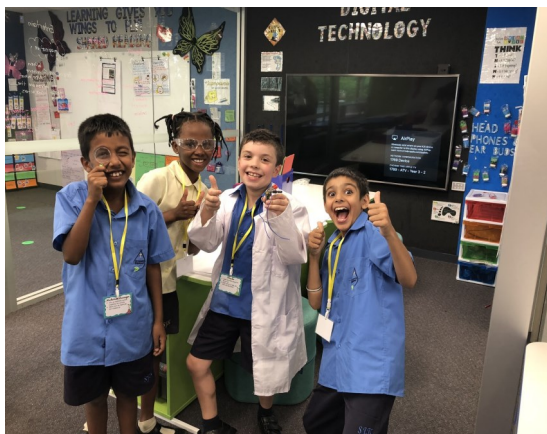
Term 2 Celebration of Learning in Year 3

We have been working together to solve complex problems across KLA's using higher order thinking!

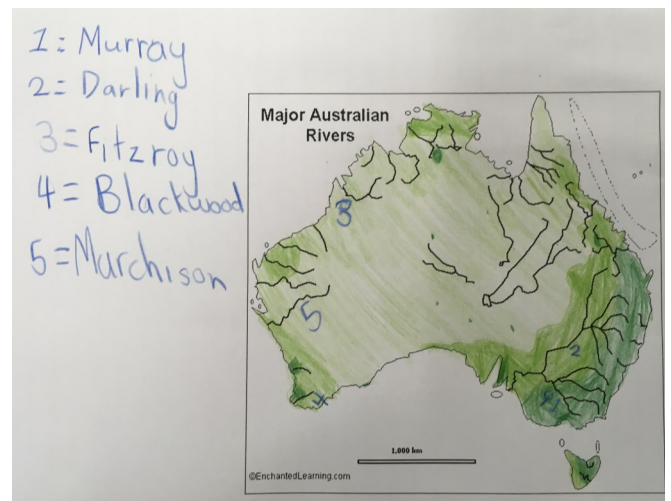
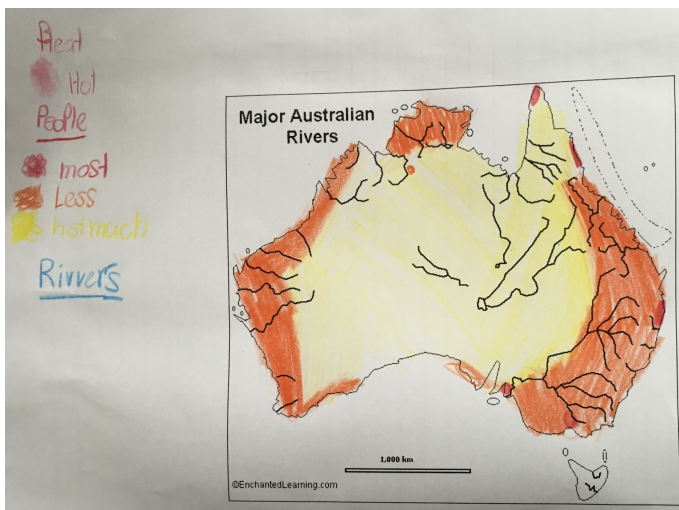

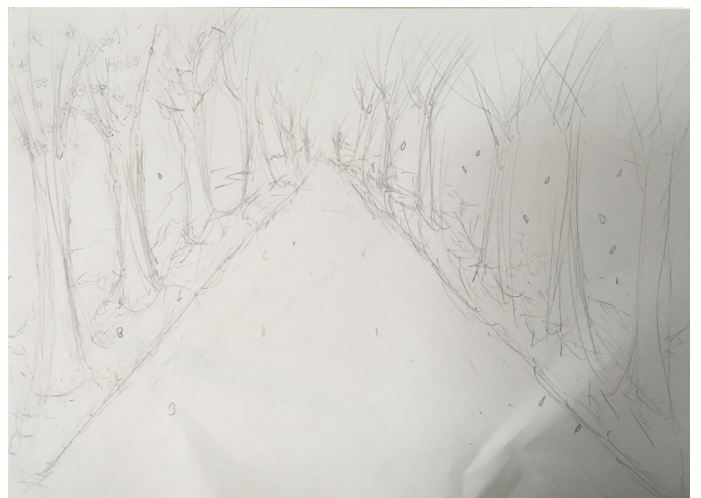
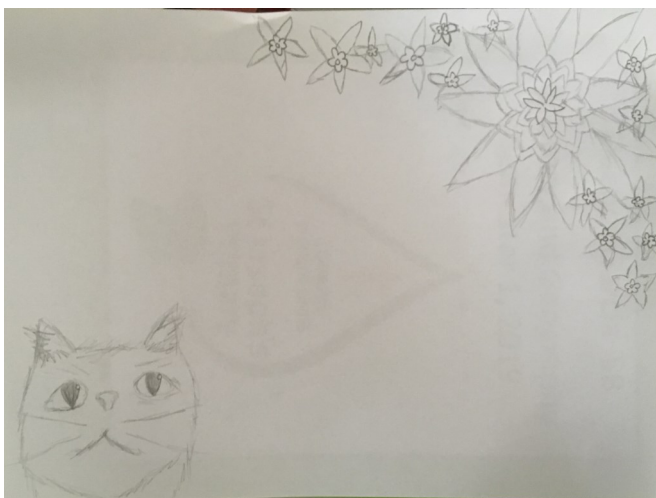
Year 5!

Here are some maps of Australia that the students have researched to find, rivers and population.

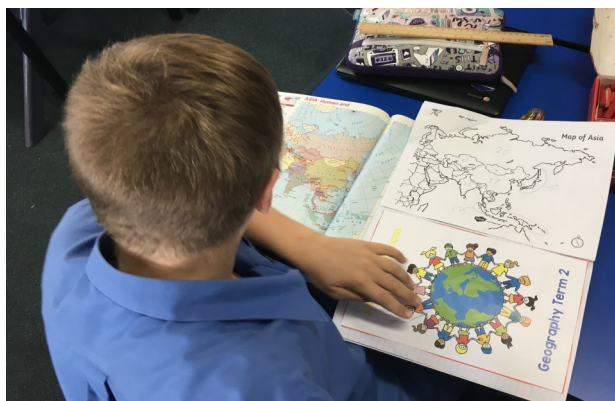
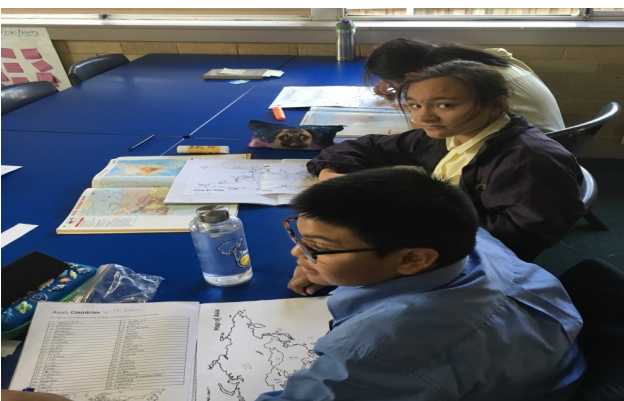
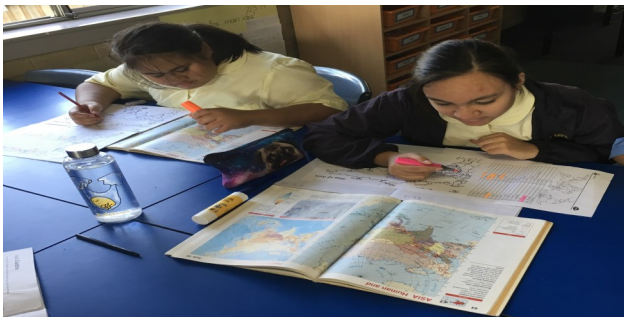
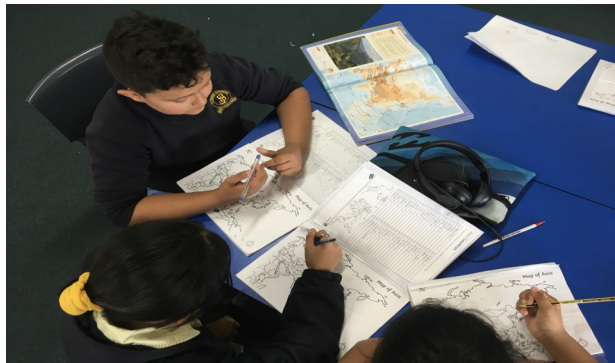


In Art, Year 5 have also learnt about balance between objects in their drawings and about vanishing points and perspective drawing.



YEAR 6

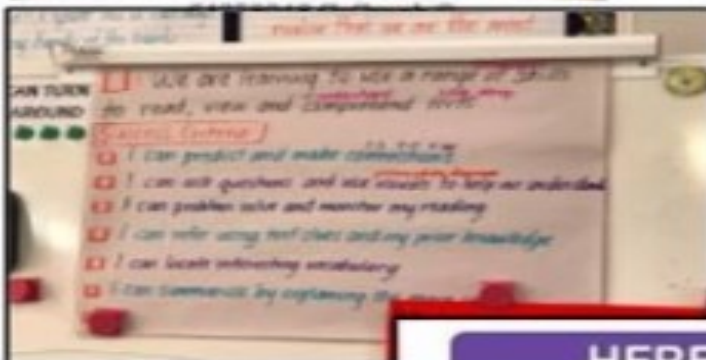

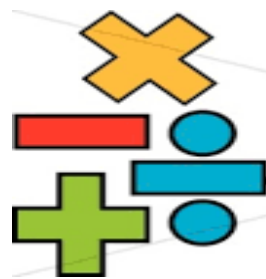
