










Year One shared their favourite monster stories with a special visitor. Mrs Reilly thought the stories were a bit scary, but we thought they were really funny.












Term 2 Celebration of Learning in Year 3




In Term 2, Year 5 have been studying "People and the Environment", how the environment influences people, their history and settlement patterns and how in turn, the people change the environment to suit themselves.

In Art, Year 5 have also learnt about balance between objects in their drawings and about vanishing points and perspective drawing.





